**N.B: Daily fishing start time can be modified in accordance with tide and weather conditions. All teams will be notified before hand in case of any change.**

**Competition General Rules:**

**FIPS-M rules and IGFA specifications.**

All competitors should submit to organizer a medical certificate which attest that they are suited the practices of sport fishing competition. Competitor who fails to submit medical certificate will be seen by the doctor provided by the organizer who will provide necessary medical check and the certificate. Cost of medical examination and certificate will be charged to the competitor or his federation. The national federation must indicate on the registration form the birth date of each team member.

All participants/ competitors in the Championship implicitly accept ALL the sports anti-doping rules of WADA.

Classification should be established by weight 1 gm = 1 point (see FIPS-M rules)  
Minimum size of fish accepted in Competition is 12 cm. Smaller fish should be put back to sea. All species of the family of mackerels are not accepted to the classification.  
Minimum size of hooks used is hook no. 10. The use of stainless hooks or others which are not corroded by salt water are forbidden.  
Line class should not exceed 20 lb.  
All participants should wear beach shoes while fishing.

Each team should bring a CD with the nation's national anthem and two flags of its country, one big and one small flag.

**All types of fishes allowed by FIPS/M & IGFA can be confirmed.**

**Fishing Tackle:**

Maximum of 20 lb. Line class.

The main line can be made of monofilament or multifilament lines. The choice of the line material is up to the angler, steel/metal excepted.

Only single hooks of any kinds are allowed.

A trace used during the competition, is only allowed to have three single hooks maximum.

Each team will be given natural bait on a daily basis (250 gm. shrimps & 250 gm. Squid/competitor / day). To the natural bait handed over by the organizer are allowed on the hook-lines attractive materials, like bright spoons, colored floating, and no floating pearls (maximal size, 15 mm.) , colored feathers, fluorescent parts and s.o. may be used on the trace. The use of baits other than those supplied by the competition management entails the disqualification.

The use of tackle other than that authorized entails the disqualification.

The hook-line is the part of the trace with the hooks. On the hook-line is allowed a maximum of three floating pearls and the hook-line can have a maximal length of 35 cm. It is allowed to use an elastic bank for fixing the baits on the hook. The hooks are to be provided in any case with natural baits. The use of odorous materials is not allowed.

The angling with a rod and reel is obligatory.

The accepted maximum length of the rod is 5 meters. The rod must have a minimum of 3 rings on the blank and one top ring. The number of reserve rods is free. They can be prepared to the swirl-clamp/swivel on the mainline can be held in reserve. Any amount of traces can be prepared and baited/lured. The rod holders/stands should be set on the dry shore of the sea, approximately in the middle of the drawn angling place.

The competitor has a free choice of the reel.

Each team will be allowed five (5) rods and five (5) reels

Lures should be in keeping with IGFA rules.

The equipment of each angler must include suitable tackles for measuring, for loosening the hooks and for killing the fish.

Tackles for landing of the fish such as catch nets or gaffs are authorized.

### **Fishing Regulations:**

The competition is organized according to ethics and **specifications** Egyptian Angling Federation, FIPS-M rules and IGFA specifications.

Each participating nation has only one representative in each sector.

The playing/drilling of the fish must be done from dry shore of the sea.

For casting and landing the fish, permission to enter the water for a short time may be given provided that the knee limit will not be exceeded and this for security measures for the competitors.

Casting is permitted from all places, in the front and the back parts of the drawn shore sector..

The action of casting is only allowed, if a competitor adjacent to the angler casting is not standing in front of him.

The bait must be cast into the seashore area in front of the drawn shore sector. A slanting cast, which endangers and disturbs other competitors is prohibited.

In extreme weather conditions heavy leads or leads with flukes must be used. The minimum weight of the used ground weight can not be lower than 50 gm.

The competitor is free to use for casting leads of his choice weights of any shape or kind as long as they do not drift into the lines of adjacent competitors after casting, and as long as the other competitors are not disturbed.

In case of doubt the measuring tackle of the competitor commissary is valid. If we have any problems of identification of the fish or of the minimum size, the competitor must immediately ask the advice of the steward. Where fish are not killed, they will be kept with the trace in a bucket filled with seawater, until the commissary has verified the capture of the fish.

Fishes under minimum sizes of which angling is not allowed, must be put back into the sea immediately.

If a fish has in his mouth or in his body several hooks of the same angler, the fish will take into account for classification.

The fish, which is hooked with a hook in his body and not in the mouth, is accepted for the classification.

A fish hooked in the mouth by a hook of a competitor and afterwards the same fish is hooked by the tackle of another competitor, the fish of the competitor whose hook is in the mouth, is accepted for the classification. If a fish is hooked in the mouth by the hooks of two different competitors, the fish is not accepted to the classification..

The intentional "hooking and snatching up" entails the disqualification.

In case of line breaking, it's possible to get back the fish only if he is on the sand of the beach. If the fish is already into the water, it is not possible to get back them by hand with the line and so the fish is not accepted to the classification.

When the gaff is used for landing a fish, only the commissary or the adjacent competitors may help and at the same time go into the water.

A competitor who tries to bring a dead fish under minimum size, or fish which angling is not allowed to introduce these fishes or not caught by himself into the classification, shall be penalized by 10 points for each undersized fish..

Contact with persons other than the commissary or the director of the competition is prohibited, with the exception by a special authorization of the team captain. It is forbidden to use mobile phone or other transmitter-receiver during the competition. If for personal reasons (illness or other) the competitor must telephone, he must ask for authorization by the steward.

Competitors who disassemble their fishing tackle and stop fishing prematurely without good reason, and without permission of the steward, must be disqualified. Fishes caught beforehand are not accepted.

Permission to leave the competition place for a short time is only given, if the steward or the direct adjacent competitors are informed in advance.

At the end of the competition, the competitor has to take his line immediately out of the sea and he must stay at the competition place until the steward has checked the result of their final catch.

The competitor is required to verify the results on his competition card, which he must sign. In case of doubt, a remark as sign of protest must be made on the competition card, and the protest must be immediately handed over to the director of the competition. The protest must mention the reason for the protest, the date and the signature of the competitor.

The caught fishes must be held in containers that have been put at disposal by the organizer of the competition. These bags or buckets must be fastened at the top by a suitable means. They should be labeled and contain the name of the competitor, his number and the sector.

### **Protests:**

Any protest, concerning the validity of any catch, must be filed in writing, signed by the team captain and hand delivered to the **International Jury with a total of 100 €** within one hour after lines out of water time. The decision of the **International Jury** is final.

### **Scores:**

#### **General Classification:**

1 gm = 1 point (see FIPS-M rules)

### **Rewards:**

The best team will be rewarded:

The first: Gold Medal

The second: Silver Medal

The third: Bronze Medal

Trophies will be awarded to the 3 best teams and the three best classified participants in each competition from the Egyptian Angling Federation.

### **Penalties and Disqualification:**

Any notified infraction should be submitted to the International Jury for decision.

Disqualification (recommendations to follow, see FIPS-M rules and specifications IGFA):

- Failure to comply with equipment or angling regulations.
- Failing to adhere to any of the environmental regulations.
- The decision of the International Jury is final.
